

OBJECTS OF THE LAKE BONAVISTA COMMUNITY ASSOCIATION

The Objects of the Lake Bonavista Community Association are:

1. The name of the society is: LAKE BONAVISTA COMMUNITY ASSOCIATION.
2. The operations of the society are to be chiefly carried on in the City of Calgary in the Province of Alberta.
3. The objects of the society are:
 - a. To enhance and enrich the quality of life and community for its residents and members.
 - b. To acquire lands, by purchasing or otherwise, erect or otherwise provide a building or buildings for social and community purposes.
 - c. To work with the City of Calgary and other levels of government to ensure the ongoing maintenance, land allocation, and sustainability of the building or buildings.
 - d. To provide a center and suitable meeting place for the various activities of the community, as well as surrounding communities, and for consideration and discussion of questions affecting the interests of the community.
 - e. To provide for the recreation of the residents, members and others, and to promote and afford opportunity for friendly and social activities.
 - f. To encourage and promote social programs, sports programs and physical fitness programs for children, youth, and adult residents, members and others.
 - g. To provide all necessary equipment and furniture for carrying on its various objects.
 - h. To procure the delivery of lectures, information sessions and other gatherings on social, educational, political, economic and other subjects.
 - i. To develop and offer programs, activities, facility rentals, and civic engagement for its residents, members and others.
 - j. To liaise with the City of Calgary and other levels of government, as well as other relevant associations, companies, and groups on traffic, development, and other relevant issues to ensure its residents can enjoy a safe and welcoming neighborhood.
 - k. To liaise with affiliated organizations and represent the interests of its residents and members.
 - l. To sell, manage, lease, mortgage, dispose of, or otherwise deal with the property of the society.
