We recently completed a comparison in pricing with our three box sizes and 6 major grocers in the city. We are happy to report we are still coming in way below what you would pay at the stores, in some cases close to half the cost. We are proud we have been able to keep these costs down for you and your family, but ask for your understanding while we navigate through these trying times. While sometimes the weight and items in the box may be down a bit, the value of the produce inside is never compromised.
